






## Parish Vision and Planning




### Parish Heat Map


































(02 A-002) New Construction - Scheme G








#### **Rectory Plans**

- Importance of an onsite rectory for the pastor
  Diocesan requirement
- Features:
  - 2 bedroom suites, 1 guest room
  - Pastor, retired priest, seminarian
- Timeline:
  - Break ground in 2025



### Newaygo County Data

• Based on current population trends and other data analysis, Newaygo County's estimated five-year gap in total housing units is: 1,602



#### **Project Costs and Funding Plan**

- Total Cost: \$1.9 million
- Breakdown:
  - Rectory (\$700,000)
  - Church (\$1,200,000)
- Funding sources:
  - $\circ$  Rectory sale = \$300,000
  - Parish savings = \$100,000
  - Capital campaign = \$1,500,000
- Feasibility study by Breton Group
